Call for papers

The Departments of Economics at the Universities of Amsterdam, Bonn, Glasgow, Pennsylvania, Mannheim and the European University Institute in Florence are organizing the 5th European Workshop in Macroeconomics. The conference will take place in Mannheim, Germany on Friday, June 12 and Saturday, June 13. All presentations are in plenary sessions and time will be left for informal discussions. Participants are strongly encouraged to stay both days. We primarily look for applications from advanced PhD students close to completion or young post-docs.

Theoretical and empirical papers from a variety of areas are welcome. Examples of topics that would be of interest include: Endogenous Fluctuations and Growth, Asset Pricing from a General Equilibrium Perspective, Heterogeneous Agents Models, Depressions and Crises, Dynamics of the Income Distribution, Dynamics of the Labor Market, International Trade and Macroeconomics, Monetary Theory and Policy, Search and Matching Models, Continuous Time Uncertainty

Submission of papers in other areas is encouraged as well. The papers to be presented will be partly determined by the interest of the organizers and participants. There is a certain bias for high quality rather than for covering all areas. Please send papers and all enquiries to cjann@uni-mannheim.de by March 9. The final programme will be sent around in April. We will be able to cover accommodation and (up to some limit) travel expenses for all speakers.
